



## What's Coming Soon from QCEW?

One labor market information source gives you all the following and more: Employment numbers; average weekly wages; taxable wages; and top 25 employers. Based on quarterly unemployment insurance tax returns filed by employers, the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW) section of the D4 site provides comprehensive employment and wage data at varying industry levels. Here you'll discover annual information, and every three months you'll find updated QCEW data ranging from statewide down to county level geographies.

### QUESTION

Which NC industry had the greatest increase in weekly wage between Q1 2015 and Q1 2016?

Statewide, aggregating all types of ownership, data show that Management of Companies and Enterprises showed the greatest dollar increase in weekly wage (\$125.64), and Construction had the highest percentage wage increase (5.59%) between the first quarters of 2015 and 2016.
